Petty Officer 3rd Class Kyle Stzemore appreciates these events because of the feelings of cheer and friendship that are built when people sit down and interact with each other.

"I really like that these events are outlets for people to be creative, and to be creative with others," said Sizemore. "It's kind of tough being away from home, so I'm grateful to MWR for giving us a chance to celebrate the holidays early with people you live and work with."

Moments like these highlight what the holidays mean to Sailors and remind us that there is still time for fun in our packed schedule.

"For me, it means family," said Petty Officer 3rd Class Leigh Ann Kelly. "Family can include anybody: friends, family, other Sailors, basically anyone you consider that special to you."

Event Execution Explanation from Fun Boss onboard at the time:

We had a gaming club onboard (a group that did larping/magic the gathering/etc.) and I went to them first to coordinate with their president. We picked a date in the evening, out to sea, and held sign-ups for those interested in hosting a booth at the expo. We started sign ups 3-4 weeks out and got Media to design an amazing comicon looking flyer.

We ended up with 9 tables total that offered showcases in a variety of the following - Pokémon, video game building, drawing, dungeons and dragons, larping, magic the gathering, game card making, and graphic design.

About 80-100 people attended. We held the event on the AFT Mess Decks from 2000-2200. We brought out 6-8 foot white tables and provided table covers, sailors were given from 1900-2000 to set up their booths for the expo.

We voted on the tables and the information they showcased to give out gift cards for the following topics - most creative, most innovative, overall best in show booth.

Everyone loved the event. I recommend to make it as big as possible. If you got the event large enough (15-20 booths), you could consider holding it in the HB.

- Set up expo tables, chairs, speaker system, playing stations, voting boxes, prize giveaways, etc.
- Workwith CoC to get approval for participants to dress up for event
- Execute event!
 - Allow participants to interact with booth exhibitors
 - Allow participants to vote on best in show, most creative, & most inventive concept at various booths.
