10. Explain Event Execution

Supply tells the ship when they would like to cook the hamburgers and special BBQ meals. If we can fit it into the schedule, we usually always do them on a Sunday. I wasn't expecting a steel beach picnic on a 18 day underway, but we had one.

I planned a fish call from the stern gate of the ship. This is significant because folding the stern gate down to fish takes lots of coordinating between the deck department and the auxiliary engineers. The situation presented itself to be at anchor and on a Sunday Holiday routine. Fishing from the stern gate allows us to be only inches off the water, rather then off the fan tail or elevator, which is way too high to even make it worth fishing. Fish call commenced at 0700 and lasted until 0930. Two of the MWR reps who are expert fisherman assisted the crew as they walked down the well deck and onto the stern gate which was sitting at a 10 degree angle off the water. I provided 12 fishing poles and tackle for the crew. MWR reps rigged each rod for bottom fishing with a weight and a dropper hook above the weight.

The fish call lasted 2 hours and I was the first one to catch a small croaker off the bottom.

The ship was anchored about 2 miles off Coronado in sandy bottom conditions.

The next event on the steel beach schedule was the 5K run beginning at 0800. Our 5K runs are always well attended because we make them as similar to an official run as possible - like you would find out in town. We have music playing, we offer free water and we give everyone a finishing time and place. 10 laps around the flight deck perimeter is 5K.

After the 5K run, we moved into the traditional steel beach games like sumo wrestling, Big Glove Boxing and Sports.

I set up the soccer goals, the tennis fence, the volleyball net and also a checkout tent and canopy where sailors could checkout tennis rackets, balls, or other equipment.

IKE-28 Nov 2016 OIR Steel Beach Picnic

Background:

Steel Beach Picnics are fairly commonplace during a deployment. It gives the crew a chance to relax and recover in the midst of a deployment. During the 2016 OIR Campaign, the USS Dwight D. Eisenhower had two Steel Beach Picnics. Some ships have them as often as monthly. The purpose of this AAR is to lay out a foundation for hosting a Steel Beach Picnic, as we improved our event from the first to the second Steel Beach.

The event is set up to be a beach BBQ type of atmosphere typically held on the flight deck. While our first Steel Beach was confined to the Hangar Bay, the Second Steel Beach allowed us to spread out onto the Flight Deck. It is recommended that some Steel Beach Supplies such as inflatable kiddie pools, water guns, etc are brought on board prior to deployment. Having arrived 1+ months into deployment without any of those items onboard nor ability to easily acquire them, we made due with what we already had onboard.

There were over 3000 participants in our 2nd Steel Beach of Deployment. The cooler temperatures and expansion onto the flight deck resulted in a better and consistently attended event.
















MWR CASINO NIGHT RULES

- -All Players are issued 20 POINTS worth of chips
- -All Chips are a value of 1 POINT except black chips
- -BLACK CHIPS ARE VALUED AT 10 POINTS

BLACK JACK-

- -Dealer will stand on 17 or more
- -Double down on any number (bet equal or less)
- -Insurance
- -Split on Doubles
- -Minimum Bet- 2 POINTS

TEXAS HOLD 'EM-

- -Big blind-2 POINTS
- -Small blind- 1 POINT
- -Dealers have control of tempo and blind at their table

ROULETTE-

- -Outside pays 1 for 1
- -Inside pays 5 to 1
- -Minimum anywhere- 1 POINT
- -No black chips will be used

CRAPS-

- -On the Field pays 1 for 1
- -All else pays 3 to 1

Event Explanation from Fun Boss:


I did this event with all the chips being a different color but found out life is way easier for us that all chips were 1 POINT except for the black chips which were 10 POINTS. When sailors wanted to play roulette they had to exchange their chips for chips with dots around them. In the game of Roulette you can make bets all over the board and it can be difficult to keep track. To combat this, sailors exchange their chips at that table for single colored chips (black, blue, green, red, or white) that they can place all over the board and the dealer knows who to make the payouts to. Sailors exchange their chips when they leave the table.


For prizes we used a points system (15 POINTS = a shirt, 30 POINTS = a water bottle etc). Even those who didn't know how to play could just exchange their chips back in and get a prize. The next time we do this event we are going to give out custom shirts. 1 per person as long as they have 30 POINTS, in order to get through the line quicker at the end of the night.

This event relies heavily on volunteers who know how to deal. Those who don't know how to deal are still very helpful in passing out chips, helping with prize redemption, and retrieving/distributing chips to dealers.
